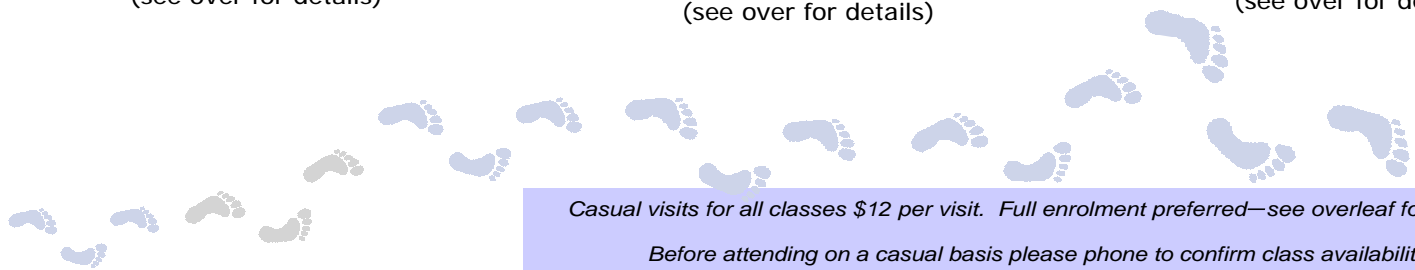

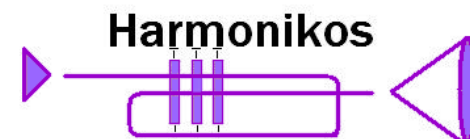
This is a new incentive, which replaces the previous "early bird" specials and encourages parents to enrol for the full semester, rather than visit on a casual basis.

Casual visits are \$12 per visit, but for those who enrol for a full semester they pay only \$96 for a block of 9 lessons, which equates to one free lesson. For those enrolling into Our Time or Imagine That, this equals a discount of \$24 over the full semester (or two free classes)!

#### Advantages of Full Enrolment:

- You save \$\$\$ - up to \$24 per semester.
- Your position in class is assured. Should a class become too big, it will be the casual visitors who will be asked to attend a different timeslot.
- The childhood development benefits to your child is significantly greater when you are committed to attending weekly.
- The social benefits to your child are significantly greater when they attend class with the same children each week.
- You can visit other classes on other days as "catch-ups" should you miss a class. A "catch-up" does not need to be in the same week— it can be at a time convenient to you.
- When parents enrol for a full semester we can efficiently plan class times and sizes in an effort to provide you with the very best service.
- You don't need to worry about weekly cash payments.

**How Does the Part Payment Plan Work?** For those enrolling into Our Time or Imagine That you can select to pay your tuition cost over two payments. The first payment of \$96 is due at enrolment, the second payment of \$96 is due in week 10—which is usually first week back after school holiday break. We will send you an invoice when the second payment is due. Home materials need to be paid for in full when they are ordered.
